From the Vicar's Desk



Dearly beloved in Christ,

We are celebrating Christmas, the birth of the Christ child, the prince of peace. This is a time of celebration of the hope that God offers in the little manger of Bethlehem. The song of the angels enthralled the shepherds who kept their flock at night. It is more than a new song; it is the announcement of God's involvement in the world of sin, pain and destruction. Joseph was a stranger there, though he had historical connection to Bethlehem. He had none to accommodate even in that momentous time. It was an anxious; stressful moment. Therefore it's a story of insecurity and stress. Christmas is the movement of new dawn that challenges and encourages the people to move from margin to the center to share their experiences of hospitality in Christ. The center receives light from the margins and is challenged to embark upon journey to find creative space that accommodates the 'other'. In this both the center and the margin experience the salvation of God, the good news of great joy!

As we bid farewell to the old year, we generally introspect the year past and make new resolutions. Our intentions are good, but as the year progresses we find that most resolutions fall by the side. If we take a look at our daily life, we realize that we are mostly dealing with people, material things and situations or events. Everybody has to respond to various situations or events. Reformation of the Malankara Church

Palakunnathu Abraham Malpan and Kaithayil Geevarghese Malpan were professors in Old Seminary (Theological College of the Church) in Kottayam. They were concerned about the need for reformation in the church. Their study of the Word of God and association with CMS (Church Missionary Society) missionaries helped them realize fully the meaning of the gospel and the freedom of the children of God. In 1836, Abraham Malpan and Geevarghese Malpan along with 10 other priests submitted a memorandum to the then British Resident requesting him to make necessary changes in the Church. This is called the Trumpet Call of Reformation in the Church. Their memorandum did not have the desired effect. Therefore Abraham Malpan and Kaithayil Geevarghese Malpan decided to take steps towards reformation while remaining within the Church. Icons, pictures, statues, and drawings of saints were removed from homes, churches, and places of worship. All prayers, worship and devotion to the Virgin Mary and the saints were omitted. All prayer requests to dead and prayers to uplift the dead from sin and suffering were omitted. Insisted that Sunday services are to be held in a reverent and spiritual way. During that time reading and expounding scriptures is to be done. Conducted worship services, including Holy Communion in the mother tongue, Malayalam. Holy Communion was not celebrated when there were none to receive. Mandated that communion under both kinds should be distributed separately. Considered the practice of praying for the dead and of doing obeisance at their graves with lighted candles as abhorrent. Intercession of saints and prayers for the dead were discarded. Auricular confession was discontinued. Believed that those who come for confession should ask for forgiveness with fasting and prayer, instead of offering oil, incense and candles. Insisted that bishops should ordain only candidates who have been examined by them and the malpans (Meaning:- Syriac scholars). Repudiated the custom of smearing charcoal on the forehead on Ash Wednesday.

Yeldho Nombu beginning from 1st Dec to 25th December

This period, before the 25th of December, is called the Advent. In Latin, the word Advent means "the coming." Starting Sunday, the 1st of December, the Holy Church will start the Holy Advent Fast (Yeldho Noumbu). Yes, yet again, another LENT. Thus, this period of fasting is a preparation in connection with the Feast of the Advent of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Mar Thoma Sabha Dinam - December 21

Traditionally, the Feast of St. Thomas is celebrated on December 21st
