



Dearly beloved in Christ

Greetings to you all in the name of our Risen Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ

During the Lent season we remember the message of the Cross. Cross is a challenge to change our ordinary situations to extra ordinary experiences. While we meditate on the resurrection of Jesus, there were many who witnessed the crucifixion of Jesus, but only few, the faithful who witnessed the resurrection.

Christian mission is validated from an empty tomb and the risen presence of Jesus. Mary of Magdalene came to anoint the body of Jesus but instead she saw the empty tomb, and also encountered the risen presence of Jesus. She went to the disciples and said about it. Peter and another disciple came and saw the empty tomb. Then they remembered what Jesus said and believed. The risen presence of Jesus strengthened their faltering steps to become joyful witness of the resurrection.

Now the whole world is under the threat of a pandemic. It once again reminds us about the human limitations in facing the crisis. Psalms 23 says, "The Lord is my Shepherd, I shall not want. He leads us to green pastures and the still waters". The Psalmist says, "Even if I walk through the valley of shadow of death, I will not fear because your presence is with me". The great assurance of the presence of Christ is well affirmed in the promise of the risen Christ to his disciples in Matthew 28: 20, "I will be with you till the end of ages".

The cross and the resurrection thus provide us a contemporary as well as the eternal presence of God in Jesus. In the Gospel according to John, all the seven miracles done by Jesus are mentioned as the signs of the Kingdom of God. The first sign that Jesus did was changing of water into wine. The presence of Jesus changes our situations. Crucifixion is glorification. The lifting up of Jesus on the cross is glorification. The great assurance of the presence of Christ is affirmed in the resurrection appearances of Jesus Christ. The crucified and risen Christ empowers us to transcend the pandemic and all the related challenges and continue to reinvent the mission of love in the context of the New Normal.

May God strengthen us through His indwelling presence with us.

Greetings to you in the name of our Risen Christ!

We now conclude our Lenten pilgrimage to Easter. Easter is the central foundation of all our Christian faith. In the death and resurrection of Jesus we find hope, light and eternity in the Risen Lord.

Easter is a day of victory of goodness against evil and darkness. Different streams of the darkness are increasing day by day in and around us. It is a fact that war, displacement, violence, poverty, debt, economic anarchy, religious and communal polarization for political gain, and religious and racial and ethnic differences are on the rise today. In the midst of all this, only the love and patience shown by Christ and the willingness to sacrifice oneself for others can lead the world to the light of goodness. The death of Christ offers personal salvation also that helps the human to overcome sin, guilt and shame.

There is no Easter Sunday without Good Friday. One of the most striking elements of all the Gospel writers is that Jesus is still wounded even after His resurrection. The crucifixion wounds do not heal. They remain open, eternally. The resurrected body of Christ remains marked by his earthly suffering, forever. His wounds are the marks that point the resurrected Christ continuously searching for the salvation of human souls. The great prophet Isaiah prophesied the same long before that 'By His Wounds We Are Healed.' Isaiah 53:5. I share a wonderful story which I read long before about St. Teresa of Avila. One day the devil appeared to her, disguised as Jesus. St. Teresa wasn't fooled for even a second, dismissing the devil. Before leaving, the devil asked her, 'How could you be so sure I wasn't Jesus?" "You didn't have any wounds – Christ has wounds!" it is true that there are still wounds in all the struggles for justice. The people who are ready to be wounded for others are all around us. Their wounds do not embitter them but become fountains of compassion and hope for others.

Easter clearly tells us that Christians are messengers of the good news; the life, the mission, the death and resurrection of Jesus. Paul reminded the believers in Ephesus that the same power that raised Christ from the dead is the power available to us who believe. It is a power that enables us to live a life of joy, victory and to Act with courage and compassion in relation to others. Let us all believe in the risen Christ and the power given to us through our belief. I pray the resurrection experience be an everlasting motivating power for our Christian life.

His Grace Most Rev. Dr. Theodosius Metropolitan, the Supreme head of our Church, is visiting Kuwait for the first time since becoming Metropolitan. Metropolitan Thirumeni will visit all seven parishes in Kuwait from April 7 to 18. His Holiness leads the Easter Holy Communion in our parish. I urge all the parishioners to participate in the evening prayers during the Passion Week and joyfully attend the Holy Qurbana services associated with Great Lent.

As per the directive from the Metropolitan, the Diocesan Episcopa has informed me to continue as Vicar till the visa is issued for the new Vicar. My family is leaving Kuwait on 30th of April. I am so grateful to all parish members for your caring support and prayers which you have offered to us throughout the ministry here in Kuwait. We, also request your earnest prayers that will help us to continue Gods ministry joyfully.

Easter blessings as you celebrate the greatness of the salvation that is God's free gift to you through Jesus Christ.


