From the Vicar's Desk



Dearly beloved in Christ,

As per the Church calendar the feast, celebrated on February 2, is known as The Presentation of Christ in the Temple (Mayaltho in Syriac). Another name for the feast is The Meeting of our Lord. Forty days after Jesus Christ's birth, Mary and Joseph, brought Christ to the Temple to make the customary offering for purification; a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons. According to the Law of Moses (Leviticus. 12:2-8), a woman who gave birth to a child was forbidden to enter the Temple of God for forty days. There, the prophetess Anna and the aged Simeon met them. Simeon sensed the fulfillment of Isaiah's puzzling prophecies of a virginal birth (Isaiah 7:14), and received God Incarnate just as he was promised he would before his death. Then Simeon praised God singing a hymn: "Now let Your servant depart in peace, O Master" (Luke 2: 29-32). Also, in the Temple was Anna the Prophetess. She had been a widow for many years. Anna was about eighty-four years old and spent her time in the Temple worshiping, fasting, and praying. When she saw the Christ Child she praised God and spoke of him to all who were awaiting the Messiah. After Jesus was presented in the Temple, the family returned to Galilee to the town of Nazareth. The Bible tells us that Jesus grew and became strong, and was filled with wisdom. (Luke 2:22-40).

Our Lord saw the needs of the sick and was always moved by compassion this is the reason why Jesus healed the sick. The Church continues the healing ministry of the church this is a very vast ministry. It includes healing of the soul and the healing of the Body. To help the healing of the body especially the poor and those in need, the Mar Thoma church has a body called its Medical mission. The challenge is not just finding out monetary help for the mission but the need of the hour is to be volunteers the in mission hospitals, medical centers etc. Particularly who are trained in the field of medicines and paramedicines. Thereby transcending the healing touch of Jesus to those in need. We as the body of Christ shoulder the responsibility to render our Presence to the sick. When sickness is permanent, it becomes the responsibility of both the family as well as the church to accept the person and accompany him/her with the compassion of Christ. Soothing words and empathetic presence can bring inner healing that is visible only to the afflicted.

The Fast of Ninevites is one of the most strictly observed fasts in the Syrian Church tradition. This fast lasts for three days beginning on the Monday, the third week before the beginning of the Great Lent. The origin of this fast was to commemorate a miraculous cessation of plague which broke out in the region of Beth-gammae. When struck with disaster, the faithful of the place gathered in the Church to pray and began to do great acts of penance and the plague ceased suddenly. To remember this great mercy of Lord, this fast came to be observed annually. Since it is observed for three days, it is commonly known as Moonnu-noyambu (three days fast) in the Malankara Church. It is also known as the fast of Jonah since it commemorates the conversion of Nineveh through the preaching of prophet Jonah. It is time for the penitential practice for the whole Church and the Church does her penance and prayers like that of Jonah in the belly of the big fish and that of the Ninevites.

God spoke and challenged us through the Word of God by our Mar Theethos Thirumeni during the Marubhoomiyile Maramon Convention. I would like to extend my sincere gratitude to all involved in organizing the convention this year. As the church prepares for the 124th Maramon Convention, let us pray for the blessing of the convention.

As we are moving to the end of this financial year, so we need to fulfill our promises of support to the missionary work of the diocese and parish in different levels. We as a parish are indeed blessed with a church for worship and other activities, so we need to be more active and make our presence in the NECK compound . May God continue His Guidance upon us to become a great witnessing worship community.

MARAMON CONVENTION മാരാമൺ കൺവൻഷൻ

Malankara Mar Thoma Syrian Church

മലതര മാർത്തോമ്മാ സുറിയാനി സഭ

The **Maramon Convention**, one of the largest Christian convention in Asia, is held at Maramon, Pathanamthitta, Kerala, India annually during the month of February on the vast sand-bed of the Pampa River next to the Kozhencherry Bridge. It is organized by Mar Thoma Evangelistic Association, the missionary wing of the Malankara Mar Thoma Syrian Church.

The origin and growth of this annual get-together for one week at a stretch can be traced to the great revival movement which gathered momentum during the reformation period in the Syrian Churches of Kerala under the pioneering leadership of Abraham Malpan in the latter part of the 19th century. This brought about the transformation in resurgence of the ancient apostolic Churches in Kerala founded by St. Thomas the Apostle in AD 52.

By 1894, a number of small supportive prayer group communions emerged and this paved a way for revival. They had regular meetings in various parishes. Because the number of people attending these meetings was growing; the need was addressed by deciding to have a meeting of these groups in a wider level at a central accessible place. This was a venue for dimensional spiritual edification that is applicable, biblically sound, ideal and value based for striving with the realities of the world and never a place for signs, wonders and miracles. During the 19th century, people began to occupy hilly places which resulted in felling of forests in and around the catchment area of Pampa river and started intensive cultivation of annual crops like tapioca, yams ... etc. This unplanned encroachment resulted in large scale soil erosion. Deep river with mud was filled with white sand, which turned to be congenial place to assemble for a gathering of masses. No need for any seating arrangement as people can sit on the neat white sand bed under roofs made by knitted coconut leaves. The duty of organizing this meeting was given to the Mar Thoma Evangelistic Association and the first convention was held in 1895 at Maramon.
